## At a Glance

The ACT Building and Construction Industry Training Fund Authority (TFA) provides the local area construction industry with the funding support it needs for a strong and sustainable future. Each year, the TFA develops a training plan in consultation with industry stakeholders. This year, the TFA will be investing \$3.715m to support training and development for the ACT and Region.

## TRAINING PROGRAMS



### Upskilling

- Inclusion Funding of \$90,000 to support three groups: Woman in non-traditional vocations, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people & Mature Age apprentices (25 years and over) entering apprenticeships.
- Providing support to rehabilitated workers for return to work training.
- Language Literacy Numeracy Digital (LLND) funding support.

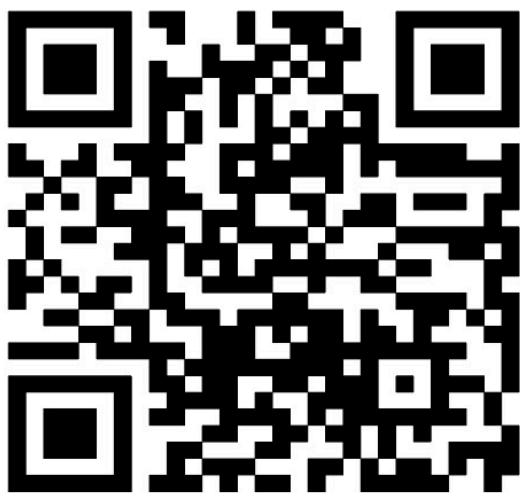

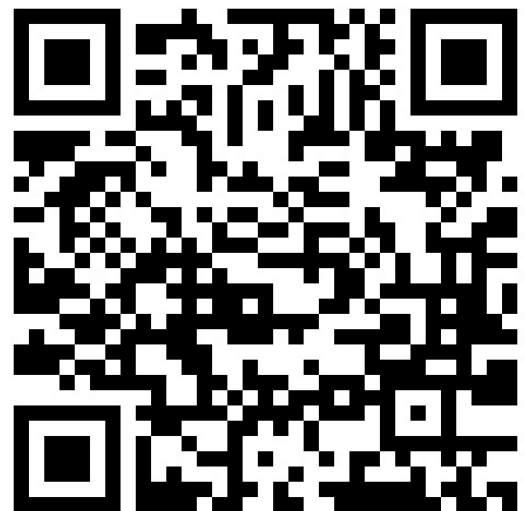
